From the Desk of the Baronial Exchequer:

As of 5/29/19, we have \$6,258.64 in the account.

We received from Gulf Wars a check for \$127.61 from their profits, proportionate to volunteer hours donated by citizens of the Barony. I recommend that this amount be put in the Wall Fund to be used towards the WoW Wall.

The WoW Wall fund would therefore have a total of \$527.61 in it, available for purchase of materials for constructing the wall.

The site for Hidden Mountain Baronial Birthday and Investiture will cost an approximate \$1,190.00, leaving the Barony with \$5,068.64.

WE also have 3 outstanding (uncashed) checks for a total of \$61.78, dropping us further to \$5,006.86. Insurance certificate for HMBB&I will be \$50, although we won't need to purchase that until January of next year.

Minutes of the Canton Meeting, Canton of Tear's-Sea Shore, May 19, 2019.

Called to Order – 5:39 PM. Present: Jorunn, Adendra, Alisoun, Diana, Yvonne, Seifred, Geoffrey

Officers' Reports:

Seneschal: – Seifrid is now formally warranted as deputy seneschal. At Hawkwood Baronial Birthday Alisoun completed the Seneschal 201 course; Seifred took the 101 and 201 course and Ingvar also took both classes so that all three have met all seneschal requirements.

Exchequer: We have \$3641.18 after paying \$300 for the new Manannan site. Quarter 1 report was sent in on time.

Chatelaine: Demo for North Charleston on 4 May; coordinated by Seifrid, was a great success as we collected 7 names and contacted them and at least one has responded so far. Hospitality Hall every Wednesday evening at Jorunn's has been successful 11 people at the most recent one. So far discussions on events and what to prepare/bring. Has 3 interested from construction college, and one new gentleman, Calvin Duke, is interested in both fighting and IS a blacksmith. Found one dress in donated garb with pins still in it and pulled from stock until it can be neutralized.

Webminister: Cleaning up the website, asked for minutes to be sent her for inclusion on the website. (April minutes were provided.)

Arts & Sciences: Report was filed; there was then much discussion of ongoing projects and sharing of resources.

Old Business:

North Charleston Demo: This went really well, 13 of us and a couple from outside the Barony participated, and the archery was a raving success. Beornwyn did a good job teaching Viking wire weaving; young girls left still talking about it and brought back other kids to learn. City (North Charleston) very much wants us to do it again next year.

Warriors' Games: Spiked and flyer is on line. Date is 13 July at "the usual site" (Harleyville American Legion).

Manannan MacLir: Spiked and on the calendar for the last Saturday of January ("the traditional date"). Given the major increase in cost of Givhans Ferry, the site is Harleyville Community Center; which has been upgraded since we last used it. The site cost is \$200 and \$100 deposit we get back. We booked the hall for Friday night to decorate Hall with the actual event Saturday. This is a dry site with no camping permitted.

WoW Wall: Bish received \$40 from Yvonne snd Ellen at the meeting for wall panels.

Fall Crown Tourney: Alisoun talked to His Highness extensively via phone and in person at Hawkwood. The overarching theme is early sixteenth century German; for visuals, think Durer's Triumph of Maximilian. Actual Tourney will be at 1PM on Saturday preceded by processional. Morning will be Youth List Tourney with procession, heraldic announcements, etc. Court at 5PM; Dinner at 6. No Consort lunch, instead starting at 10ish a brunch of typical breakfast foods open to all (cost to be covered by donations from Barony Members as a gift to the Kingdom). Site tokens will be cast pewter rings designed and production supervised by Patris de Terra Lepori. A&S – Tempora Atantia run by Kingdom A&S; His Highness and the autocrat also plan at least two other competitions.

New Business:

Hidden Mountain Baronial Birthday and Investiture: After a conversation with Ingvar at Hawkwood, Their Highnesses have committed to attending on the last weekend in March. The event has been Spiked and should be on the calendar shortly. The anticipated site is Sandy Ridge Girl Scout Camp in Bennettsville; More information to come at Baronial Commons June 2, 2019
