

SHORE REPORT

Alisoun completed the required Seneschal 201 class at Hawkwood Baronial Birthday.

Seifrid Wolfhart is now formally warranted as deputy seneschal and completed both the required Seneschal 101 and 201 class at Hawkwood Baronial Birthday.

As some of you may be already be aware from Facebook Jorunn has been holding Hospitality Hall every Wednesday not only for newcomers but also for other interested members of the canton.

Jorunn also arranged for a webinar to allow several members of the canton to get the required Marshal 101 class. As a result of that, Jorunn is once again fully warranted as a marshall and five other members are now marshalls in training.

Manannan mac Lir is now Spiked and on the calendar for 25 January, 2020. Given a major increase in the price of Givens Ferry and improvements at the Harleyville Community Center, we are returning to Harleyville for Manannan.





Minutes of the Canton Meeting for Tear's-Sea Shore on June 16, 2019.

The meeting was called to order at approximately 5:00 PM at the home of Geoffrey d'Ayr of Montalban. Among those attending in person in addition to Geoffrey were Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane, Beornwyn Bjarnardðóttir, Bjarki de Rouen, Constantia in der lachun, Guillaume de Bracy, Heinrich Wilhelm von Anspach, Hildegard von Anspach, Jorunn nic Lochlainn, Mikie, Ysabeau de Horres, Yvonne Montclair. William Costello attended by telephone conference call.

Officers' Reports:

Seneschal: – Required classes for both seneschal and deputy seneschal are up to date with Seneschal 101 and 201 for both Alisoun and Seifrid. The second quarter report is the only thing due in the immediate future. Since the canton seneschal's report is due well before any of the other officers' reports, Alisoun requested that officers provide to her at least a brief summary of any information which they would like included in her seneschal's report no later than 1 July (e.g., warranting classes taken or new warrants issued, A & S activities, new members, etc.). Alisoun also requested that any meetings or classes scheduled by/for other officers (e.g., cooking or other A & S sessions) be placed on the web calendar if at all possible.

Chatelaine: Jorunn reported the following for the period 20 May – 16 June:

Three new members have joined the Shore: Martyn Delo, Calvin and Zach. Heinrich Wächter, who was previously quite active in the East Kingdom, has now relocated to the Shore.

Hospitality Hall continues every Wednesday Night between 7pm and 10pm. Topics this month as follows:

May 22 - Developing personas and stories were shared and soon to be posted to the Shore website.

May 29 - Read the "First Tourney" on how the SCA started.

June 5 – Talked about events and more specifically what to expect at Warriors' Games

June 12 - Favors/Tokens for fighters, what they are, why they are given. Also had everyone create accounts on the AEL and explained the use of it.

Jorunn also sent follow-up emails to those who showed interest at the May 4 demo.

On June 8 Bjarki, attended his first event, Journey through the Nine Realms. Having completed Armored Marshal 101 via teleconference at Jorunn's home, he participated as an MIT at this event and was awarded a special token by Baron Lochlainn of Raven's Cove for his help marshalling on the field. Princess Signy also recognized his efforts by giving him an inkle woven belt.

Exchequer: Alisoun reported for Adendra who was unable to attend. We have \$3641.18 in the checking account after paying \$300 for the new Manannan site (Harleyville Community Center). That includes both the \$200 site fee and a \$100 deposit refundable after the event. Adendra has the second quarter report roughed out and will finalize it as soon as she receives the June bank statement.

Arts & Sciences: Yvonne reported that periodic garb workdays would be being held on Tuesday evenings starting on 7 PM on 25 June at Geoffrey's house. The first session will be aimed at planning for Fall Crown whose theme is early German sixteenth culture. (Alisoun suggested that people look at the "Triumph of Maximilian" for visual hints.) Geoffrey, Yvonne and others will also provide newer members with simpler field garb for upcoming camping events.

Jorunn indicated that she plans to add Monday Night Lamp Work classes/open shops at 7PM at her apartment in Summerville.

Webminister: Jorunn indicated that some business meeting minutes were still missing but should be added soon. The webministers are looking for new content from the populace, particularly, photos of Society activities to liven up the site. Story submissions and articles are also very much encouraged and welcomed. The intent is to show others that we are active and what we are up to, to draw others in. (Please remember that appropriate waivers/releases must accompany any submissions not consisting of official reports or published event flyers, etc.)

Jorunn reported that she continues to work with Sala, the baronial webminister to complete updates to that site in a timely manner.

Alisoun asked if it would be possible to create dedicated pages on the Shore website for the two big events coming up (Warriors' Games and Manannan mac Lir) to allow greater visibility of the events. Jorunn agreed and will report later progress.

Marshal: Jorunn reported for Getulio who was unable to attend. On May 28 six people attended an Armored Marshall 101 class via webinar at Jorunn's apartment. During the class, five people were registered for the Marshall in Training (MIT) program; Heinrich Wächter, Heinrich Wilhelm von Anspach, Bjarki de Rouen, Guillaume de Bracy and Seifrid Wolfhart. Having taken the current version of the class Jorunn is now officially warranted once again as an armored marshal in Atlantia.

Minister of the Lists: That office is still vacant and there was some discussion of the requirements for becoming a fully warranted lists officer since the barony as a whole often has to "borrow" list officers from other groups for events.

Old Business:

Warriors' Games: Alisoun reported for Adendra who was unable to attend. The traditional game components have been located and checked out and the sheep are currently being repaired! There was a discussion of personally owned games like kubb and kayles which may be in storage or in personal travel kits and folks were encouraged to bring those if possible as well as game boards for indoor activities for those who prefer to stay in air conditioning.

Everyone was reminded that water balloons and water guns were a hit last year and to expect to get wet this year again. Please wear garb that can withstand getting wet! Donations of more water balloons and super shooters from the dollar store are always welcome.

As usual, this is a free event and the feast is a potluck with two meats provided by the canton. Check with the autocrat if you would like suggestions for shared dishes.

This is the canton's "Picnic in the Park" so for ease of set up and tear down we recommend pop-up day shades rather than period pavilions. Lady Yvonne volunteered her two 10 x 15 pop-up pavilions to help shade everyone. Those intending to bring day shades please coordinate with the autocrat.

Manannan mac Lir: Alisoun reported for Adendra who was unable to attend. The site is now paid, and the contract has been signed. The event is also "Spiked" on its traditional date on the last weekend of January. Before signing the contract the autocrat verified that handicap accessible toilets are now fully functional. The site fee had been previously approved by canton meeting and the autocrat expects to present a final budget for this event no later than the August business meeting.

Fall Crown Tourney: Alisoun gave a brief report because of general interest despite this being a baronial rather than canton event. Thanks to Alisoun's illness and the need to tie down a couple more responses from kingdom officers so we can finalize the non-kingdom staff assignments, we are postponing the website and Paypal "Go Live" until just before Pennsic (i.e., three months before the event). That is about the only area that is not moving along on the

original schedule with Patris already working on the site tokens and several other projects already under way in the background. Further discussions will occur at the July Commons and the October Commons which is unfortunately scheduled opposite Coronation. [Post meeting addendum on web site scheduling: Alisoun having received back channel info that the Coronation flyers and PayPal are not yet up and may not be for a while, delay on going live with PayPal is not only not problematic but may in fact be polite.]

Hidden Mountain Baronial Birthday and Investiture: Alisoun reported again briefly that the event was officially "Spiked" and the check and contract material sent to the Girl Scouts of Eastern South Carolina. At the time of the meeting the check had not cleared, but the baronial exchequer reports that the check in fact cleared on 17 May so the site is locked in. There was some discussion at the meeting as to how much urgency there might be to substitute a new autocrat team for Alisoun as placeholder when the event is still nine months out. There are arguments both ways that seemed more appropriately dealt with at a baronial rather than a canton meeting.

War of the Wings Wall Project: Seifrid reported for Getulio who was unable to attend. Seifrid got the plans for the wall from Getulio and explained the strategy to members of the canton and answered questions since there was such interest in the project. Much of the actual work will be done at two work sessions in Harleyville in August and October in conjunction with Baronial Commons. Seifrid is co-ordinating checks for the purchase of the canvas with the baronial exchequer before the end of June so that everything was well in hand before the August Commons meeting.

New Business:

Cooks' Guild: Discussions at Hospitality Hall sessions revealed a desire for those interested in cooking to get together to discuss perhaps forming a more structured cook's guild. A 3 hour meeting was held prior to the canton meeting at Geoffrey's home with some of those interested. Olwen and Constantia, two of the interested parties, prepared and served sample period food with explanations of their redactions.

Going forward, the Cooking Guild/Gathering will facilitate communication with a Facebook Group which is open to any members of the barony with an interest in period cooking. It will be a place for those who enjoy redacting recipes, sharing recipes or cooking them. Deputy Chatelaine: Beornwyn Bjarnardóttir volunteered to become deputy chatelaine for the Shore and was approved by a unanimous vote of the paid members attending. The paperwork for her warrant will be completed as soon as possible.

Movements in the Canton: William Costello, known as the Abbot, announced plans to relocate to the more convenient Summerville area in the near future, hopefully within the next couple of months.

Review of Upcoming Events and Canton Business Meetings:

After a brief review of upcoming events focusing on those which canton members planned to attend, dates and locations for all canton meetings through the end of October were confirmed:

July 21 at Geoffrey's at 5 PM following Baronial Commons at the same day and location August 18 at 5 PM at Ingvar and Yrsa's

September 15 at 5 PM at Seifrid's

October 13 at 5 PM back at Geoffrey's

After a unanimous vote to adjourn the meeting adjourned at 6:30PM.
