

Text following the image: "WHEREVER HE WENT A NUMBER OF WHITE BIRDS FLEW WITH HIM THE ANCIENT GODS 5 existed, for Manannan cast an enchanted mist over it which rendered it invisible. Sometimes Manannan would entice great kings and heroes to his isle, where death and sorrow were unknown, but after a time spent there, which seemed to the visitors no more than a day or two, they would return to their own people, only to find that their visit to the faery island of youth had extended over months, and sometimes years. Two very magical things Manannan possessed : one was a boat called the Ocean-Sweeper, and whoever used that boat needed neither oar nor sail—they simply wished to beat the place they were bound for, and the Ocean-Sweeper glided swiftly over the sea, and were the waves high as mountains it was not hindered in its progress. The other was a milk-white horse, Enbarr of the Flowing Mane, which could travel over the sea-waves as quickly as it could on land, and never get wet; it could fly through the air, too, more swift!"





December Commons

December 21, 2019 As recorded by Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane

- I. Officers Reports
 - a. Youth Officer Barony will need a new Youth Officer, as Katherine of the Doves has accepted Kingdom Youth Officer position.
 - b. Chatelaine Barony will need a new Chatelaine Slaine has reached the end of her warrant period and would like to step down.
 - c. Herald Barony will need a new Herald, as Patris is stepping down from the position. There is a potential candidate, who was not able to attend the meeting.

These will all need to be advertised in the Mayhem

NB: Anyone interested in these Baronial Offices is welcome to apply – please write to the Baronial Seneschal, Ingvar Erlingsson, and copy the current holder of the position.

d. Exchequer – As of this date, the Baronial Checking Account contains \$7051.92; the WoW Wall Designated fund contains \$115.44 (included in the baronial total).

Still outstanding are the checks for \$40 each for site rental for the American Legion Hall in Harleysville SC for the August 24 and October 5, 2019 Baronial Commons meetings / Wall Painting, and \$63.69 checks for refunds for Silver Chalice.

This will leave the Baronial Account with \$6908.27and the WoW Wall Designated Fund with \$115.44.

We anticipate retrieving \$150 of the site cost for Silver Chalice as a refundable deposit.

There was discussion about the difficulty in contacting the site about the refund of the deposit; Esme will continue to work on obtaining the refund.

Barony moved, seconded and passed renewing the existing WoW Wall designated fund for one more year, until December 31, 2020.

- II. Old Business
 - a. Baronial Polling ability to choose electronic polling closes on January 8, 2020; the actual polling will be mailed January 11, 2020; the electronic polling will open January 15, 2020. – due to their Majesties by February 1, 2020.
 - b. Silver Chalice Geoffrey volunteered to be autocrat and was moved, seconded and voted as autocrat by the Barony. A date of August 22 was proposed and moved, seconded and approved by the Barony as the prospective date of the event. There was some discussion of using a site "just over the border" in NC, and perhaps doing the event jointly with the Shire of Seareach. The Autocrat will investigate.
- III. Shire Reports
 - a. Misty Marsh has been asked to participate in 3 demo events in 2020 (so far), 2 during weekdays for local libraries and a third on a weekend for the boy scouts, in April. Will be asking for help with these especially the latter. More information to come as it becomes available.
 - b. Moorhaven has had some changes in officers Esme. is now the Seneschal (paperwork was done at meeting); Karen Dugan will be taking over A&S; Dawna Kreis will be taking the office of chronicler.
- IV. Other Business there will be a sponsored competition at Kingdom A&S Faire; a blind novice tourney (i.e. people new to a particular art form will enter their attempts [with appropriate documentation] blind, that is the works will be judged without knowing who did what.) Both new artisans and old hands trying something new are encouraged to enter.
- V. Next Meeting will be Barony Commons on January 11th, 2020 at the Baroness's (Krystal Smith) in Florence SC.

Tear-Seas Shore Business Meetings – Nov. and Dec. 2019 & Jan. 2020

Minutes of the Canton Meeting for Tear's-Sea Shore on November 17, 2019. (DRAFT)

As reported by Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane

The meeting was called to order shortly after 5 P.M. at the home Geoffrey d'Ayr of Montalban. Among those attending in person in addition to Geoffrey were Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane, Aodh Marland called Adendra. Thylacinus Aquila of Dair Eidan, Diana of Dair Eidand, Yvonne Montclair, Sabrina Rose, Yrsa Sørkvir, Ingvar Erlingsson and Jorunn nic Lochlainn. Also present by teleconference was William Costello.

Approval of Minutes

The August, September and October minutes having been published in *Mayhem*, all three sets of draft minutes were adopted by the members attending without change except to note that the issue of the autocrat for Warriors' Games had been resolved at the September meeting whose minutes reflected that resolution.

Officer Openings and Pollings:

Minister of Lists: This office had been open and advertised for some time. A letter of intent had been received in good time from William Costello. A motion was made, seconded and approved by the members present to nominate William Costello as Minister of the Lists for the Shore.

Other offices: The advertisement for the other open offices had been accidentally omitted from the November *Mayhem* but would appear in the December issue so could be voted on in December if letters of intent were received.

Chatelaine: Jorunn indicated that Beornwyn was working on a letter of intent, but had not yet completed it. She would send it to the seneschale shortly.

Webminister: Seiffrid and Jorunn were working on separating the canton website from Jorunn's personal pages. It will be necessary to cancel the old website routing and link the new one to the kingdom address for the Shore. Jorunn indicated that the revised website in Weebly was simple to maintain and that she could teach anyone interested in applying for the Webminister position what they needed to do to maintain it.

Marshal: The seneschal had contacted Getulio via Facebook message about the vote to remove him as canton marshal, but she had had no formal response. The canton really needs a warranted heavy weapons marshal. Several members of the canton are at the

marshal in training stage and should be encouraged to consider taking on the territorial marshal role.

Officers' Reports:

Seneschal: Alisoun reported that there were issues with the branch seneschals' mailing list that were being addressed by kingdom, but there was no timeline for resolving all the problems.

Exchequer: Adendra reported that the quarterly Report was filed on time. As of the meeting there was \$3,802.18 in the checking account. She still must send checks for SCA Insurance certificate for Manannan, and for the site fee for Warriors Games. (Those checks were signed after the meeting adjourned.)

Herald: Thylacinus indicated nothing new to report.

Chatelaine: Jorunn reported that Hospitality Hall continued to be held at her home on Wednesday evenings even though she had stepped down as chatelaine.

Arts & Sciences: Yvonne reported that the Arts & Sciences competitions at Crown Tourney had gone well and that she would be running the competitions at Silver Chalice at the end of the month. She also noted that a new embroidery shop had opened in Summerville called Fire Poppies that carries several different lines of silk floss, etc. **Marshal:** Office currently vacant.

Minister of the Lists: The newly appointed MoL, William Costello, indicated that he had nothing to report other than plans to get the required course(s) and other training for formal warranting.
