

WARRIORS' GAMES

July 10, 2021

Atlantia's premier FREE event returns!

It may be July and hot, but with the waning of the plague and rumors of impending war, the warriors of Atlantia still need to train to keep themselves at the peak of performance. To encourage our fighters (and our future fighters), the Canton of Tear-Sea's Shore offers Warriors' Games, a perfectly good excuse to see our friends, have fun in the sun, and try our hands at diverse traditional games.

Bring all the A & S on which you have been laboring during the long months since last we met, to show everyone. Bring a towel, as some of the games may involve airborne water. Note that both Society-wide and Atlantian COVID restrictions will be in place, which may affect certain aspects of the event including attendance restrictions, pre-registration, and modification of some traditional games. FIGHTING: No marshal activities planned.

ARTS & SCIENCES: Open A & S display. Competition for Hidden Mountain Bardic Champion. More details from Their Excellencies Robert and Bridget closer to the date.

FEAST: Due to Society COVID restrictions the traditional pot luck feast may not occur. Individual households (in the real world COVID restriction sense) may bring food from home or acquire it from local food sources for their own use. Again due to COVID restrictions there will be no group hydration measures or the traditional snow cones. However, the canton will provide supplies of individual water bottles for personal use as Atlantian restrictions currently allow.

MERCHANTING: For information on merchanting, including any restrictions, please contact the autocrat.

OTHER: Site opens 10 a.m. Site closes no later than 9 p.m. Masks will be required of all attendees. A limited number of masks will be available for those who forget to bring theirs.

REGISTRATION NOTES: Again this is a FREE event, but preregistration is required under both Atlantian and Societywide COVID restrictions. Depending on our status under the former, attendance numbers may be limited and youth will be waitlisted until we know we are allowed to host them at local events. Note that, since this is a FREE event, there is no applicable refund policy.

a report from the

APRIL 2021 SHORE MEETING

The April 2021 Canton meeting was held at Doty Park in Summerville and via Zoom at 2:15 p.m. on 24 April, 2021.

Those attending in person included Seiffrid Wolfhart, Roibeard MacOscar, Heinrich Wilhelm, Constantia in der Lachun, Cecilia Blythe, and Detlev

Those attending via Zoom included Geoffrey d'Ayr of Montalban, Alisoun MacCoul of Elphane, and Bran Mydwynter.

----OFFICERS' REPORTS-----

SENESCHAL: Seiffrid reported the successful submission of the quarterly Seneschals report, as well as updated information on phase opening procedures passed down by Kingdom Seneschal. Warrants were also successfully signed for Alisoun to conduct business as Autocrat on behalf of the Tear Sea's shore for Warriors' Games 2021.

EXCHEQUER: Seiffrid reported for Adendra that the checking account still had \$4,559.50 in the account with all checks cleared, which remained unchanged from previous reports. Adendra also completed the draft version of the Financial Policy in the new format, which will be reviewed at the next meeting before being sent to Kingdom and Corpa for final approval. She completed the quarterly report for the Exchequer's office, and both Seiffrid and Adendra signed the documents, which were submitted and received on time.

HERALD: There is no new activity in the Herald's Office.

MARSHAL: Heinrich proudly announced that the Shore is holding its first fighter practice "Now!", as he was armored and awaiting the completion of the meeting to begin combat with Roibeard. All forms and procedures were on site according to Reopening Atlantia policies, and they were followed during this process.

MINISTER OF THE LISTS: William could not attend, but his report was identical to that since the lockdown: no progress on warrant and no need for a MoL since there has been no fighting.

MINISTER OF ARTS AND SCIENCES: Yvonne did not attend, however there are no updates

on any new projects taking place in the Canton.

WEBMINISTER: The office of the Webminister remains vacant.

CHATELAINE: Jorunn could not attend, but reported that Hospitality Hall is still active every Wednesday night at 7pm. There is still ongoing participation in this medium, but there have been no other updates regarding new members.

-OLD BUSINESS-

WARRIORS' GAMES 2021: Mistress Alisoun reported that the contract has been signed with Harleyville for the community center, and they are ready to accept us there. Despite the current policy of Atlantia indicating that at this time indoor activities will not be allowed, the interior space was rented for the utilization of its restroom facilities, as it would be less expensive than the alternatives.

MANANNAN MAC LIR 2022: Jorunn reported that she would not be able to continue as Autocrat for Manannan mac Lir 2022 due to health issues. The announcement was made by Seiffrid that any persons wishing to take on the role should submit their interest to him in a timely manner. Constantia did express verbal interest at the meeting, but with concern that she might not be able to act as both Feast Steward and Autocrat for the event at the same time. However, should someone be interested in taking her position as Feast Steward she would take on the role. Those interested in either position should contact Seiffrid via email or text.

TEAR SEA'S SHORE POLICY REVIEW: Seiffrid advised the policy changes have been drafted, and will require a bit of further refinement before publishing for review by the populace. They will be published soon and will be available for discussion at the next meeting.

There being no further business, as well as fighters who were hungry for combat after a long break due to the pandemic, a motion was made to adjourn which was carried by a roaring acclimation of those gathered. Thus marked the end of the first in-person meeting since the Plague of 2020. ▲


