

As of this date, the Baronial Checking Account contains \$5950.27; the WoW Wall Designated fund contains \$365.57 (included in the baronial total).

The Baronial Trim is on hand! 316 yards have been sold, leaving 184 yards on hand. You can order some for \$2.50 per yard, checks made out to "SCA, Inc. – Barony of Hidden Mountain" and sent to me, Robert Himmelsbach, 199 Cabrill Dr., Charleston SC 29414.

The revision of the Baronial Financial Policy to fit it into the Format required by Corporate has been done and was accepted by unanimous vote of the Barony on 3/13/2021. Subsequent revisions from the Kingdom

Exchequer have been received and we are still discussing how to make the revisions she requests. In addition, I now have to compare to the (finally!) BoD approved Kingdom Fiscal Policy (from May 2020) and make any adjustments so we conform.

Quarterly report for the first quarter of 2021 has been reviewed and accepted by Regional/Kingdom.

MAY 2021 BARONIAL MEETING

8 May, 2021—6:00pm



TSS: All reports are in. First in-person meeting and practice took place April 24th.

MISTY MARSH: Suspended. No meetings documented in 1 year. Bank signatories not up to date. No first quarter 2021 exchequer's report submitted.

MOORHAVEN: Ongoing issues with Wells Fargo bank account. Currently no bank account. Exchequer is working with regional exchequer to resolve.



SENESCHAL: If you plan to autocrat an event, check out SCARS. Paypal / SCARS systems are available to all groups in good standing. Paypal / SCARS not required, but highly recommended for complying with pre-registration requirements as well as attendance limits.

From Duchess Simone, Kingdom Seneschal:

Masks that fully cover the mouth and nose must be worn by all attendees over the age of 4 at all times and during all activities except for eating and drinking. Court, bardic circles, or any activity that involves voice projection shall also require that masks be worn at all times. Sound amplification devices are highly recommended.

No day board, water bearing, or food of any kind shall be provided by event staff or attendees to other attendees. All attendees must provide their own food and beverages.

While consuming food or beverages, attendees are required to remain stationary and follow social distancing rules.

WARRIORS' GAMES: Mistress Alisoun, Autocrat:



Youth attendance contingent on Phase 3 re-opening. Use of the hall currently limited to 1 individual at a time for use of the bathroom facilities. Sealed bottles of water to be provided. A spreadsheet will be used for pre-registration.

WARRIORS' GAMES

July 10, 2021

Atlantia's premier FREE event returns!

It may be July and hot, but with the waning of the plague and rumors of impending war, the warriors of Atlantia still need to train to keep themselves at the peak of performance. To encourage our fighters (and our future fighters), the Canton of Tear-Sea's Shore offers Warriors' Games, a perfectly good excuse to see our friends, have fun in the sun, and try our hands at diverse traditional games.

Bring all the A & S on which you have been laboring during the long months since last we met, to show everyone. Bring a towel, as some of the games may involve airborne water. Note that both Society-wide and Atlantian COVID restrictions will be in place, which may affect certain aspects of the event including attendance restrictions, pre-registration, and modification of some traditional games. For details, contact the autocrat, see the website of Tear-Sea's Shore, or consult the Warriors' Games event in the Book of the Face.

The autocrat asks that you read the following notice from the Board of the Society very carefully before making your final decision to register for Warriors' Games:

Although the SCA complies with all applicable laws to ensure the health and safety of our event participants, we cannot eliminate the risk of exposure to infectious diseases during in-person events. By participating in the in-person events of the SCA, you acknowledge and accept the potential risks. You agree to take any additional steps to protect your own health and safety and those under your control as you believe to be necessary.

FIGHTING: No marshal activities planned.

ARTS & SCIENCES: Open A & S display and a competition for Hidden Mountain Bardic Champion. For details on requirements for the Bardic Competition contact Their Excellencies Robert and Bridget.

FEAST: Due to Society COVID restrictions the traditional pot luck buffet feast will not occur. Individual households may bring food from home or acquire it from local food sources. Also due to COVID restrictions there will be none of the usual traditional shared hydration measures provided by the Shore. It is recommended that individuals and households consider providing factory sealed bottles of water or other hydration liquids under the restrictions anticipated to be in place at the time of the event.

MERCHANTING: For information on merchanting, please contact the autocrat.

OTHER: Site opens 10 a.m. Site closes no later than 9 p.m. At this time we anticipate that masks will be required of all

attendees. A limited number of masks will be available without charge for those who forget to bring theirs.

REGISTRATION NOTES: This is a FREE event, but preregistration is required under Society-wide COVID restrictions. Anyone arriving on site without having preregistered will, with great sorrow, be asked to leave site immediately.

SITE RESTRICTIONS: No camping onsite; Day shades and popups allowed. This is a DRY site. No open fires are permitted on site. Also no smoking except in designated areas. No animals in any indoor areas.

DIRECTIONS

Take your best route to Exit 177 (SC-452) on I -26. Take the exit towards Harleyville and continue for about 1.3 miles until 453 intersects at a T junction with SC-178 (Main Street). Turn left and continue until you cross the railroad tracks after about a third of a mile. Immediately after the tracks turn right onto South Railroad Avenue. The Community Center will be at 163 on your left. There will be signage for the site and for parking.


