



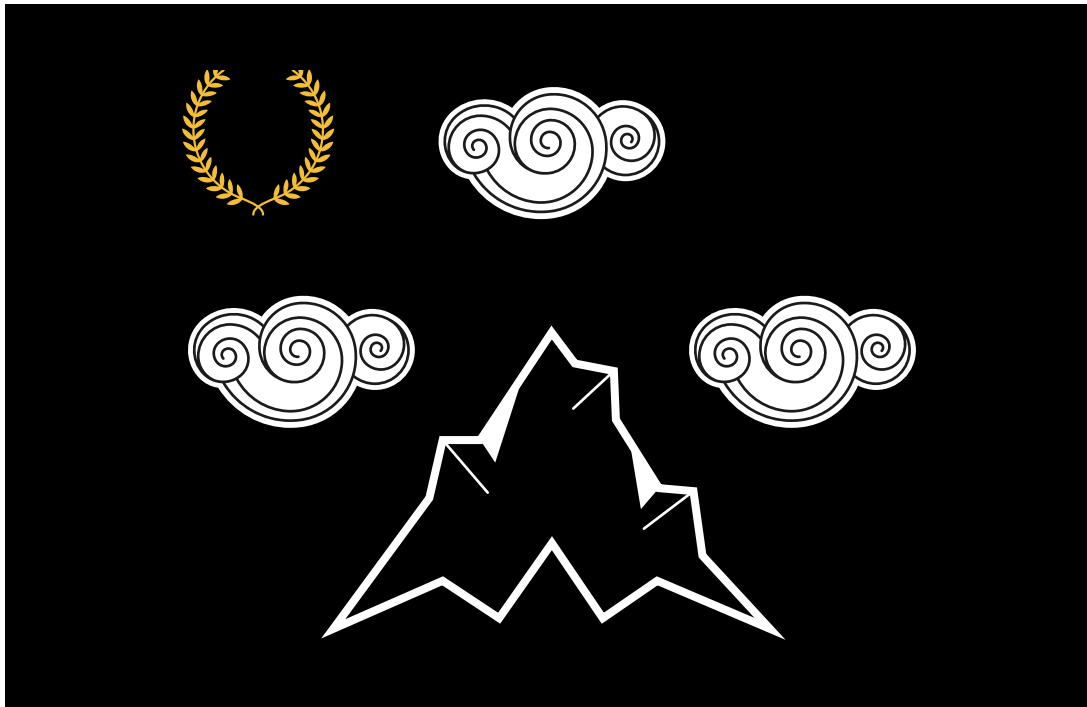

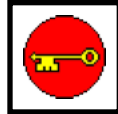

the BARONIAL EXCHEQUER

As of this date, the Baronial Checking Account contains \$6149.16; the WoW Wall Designated Fund contains \$365.57 (included in the baronial total). \$55 was paid to Harleyville American Legion to reserve their hall for December 18, 2021 for the Baronial Commons and Holiday Hooplah. All outstanding bills have been paid, and we have 1 outstanding refund check for \$5 to Lord Seiffred (HINT).

The baronial trim is on hand! 339 yards have been sold, leaving 161 yards on hand. You can order some for \$2.50 per yard, checks made out to “SCA, Inc. – Barony of Hidden Mountain” and sent to me, Robert Himmelsbach, 199 Cabrill Dr., Charleston SC 29414.

The 3rd Quarter report was filed on time, and I have been told appears to be correct.

We will be holding Hidden Mountain Baronial Birthday at Camp Sandy Ridge in Bennettsville SC on the last full weekend of April 22 – 24, 2022. I have asked Lady Esme to be Hall Steward and Lady Constantia to be Feast Steward. Mistress Alisoun will be the Registrationist, and Lady Caissene will be List Mistress. I still need a Marshall in Charge, as well as Youth and Rapier Marshals, and an Archery Marshal. We also have an opening for a Field Steward to organize setup of the lists and tentage, and a Site Steward to refresh the several restrooms, and coordinate clean-up of the hall and kitchen. someone to coordinate it. I want to hold off on putting out more detail about the event, prices, SCA-rs registration, etc. until after the new year.

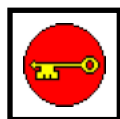
HOSPITALITY HALL

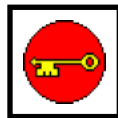

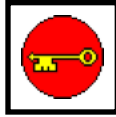

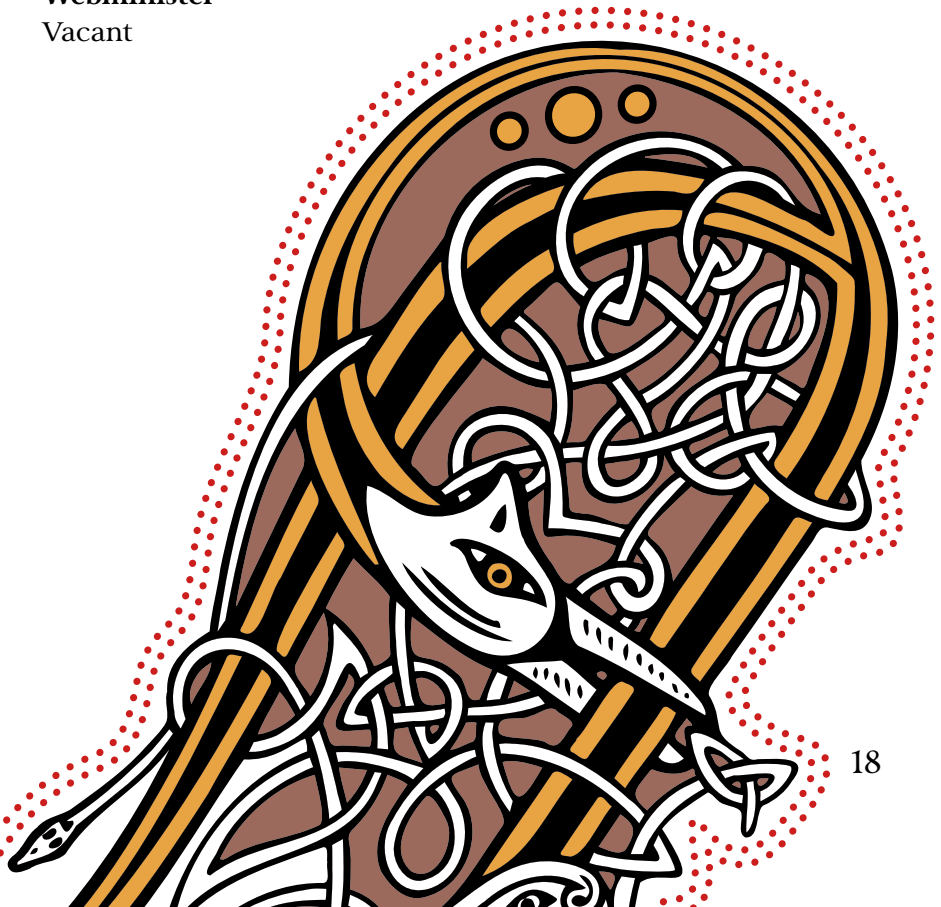
