



Thanks to Mistress Adendra for aautocrating. As always, the event went off without any major issues. The hall looked so nice; thanks to Diana and Bridget.

We had fighting: heavy, rapier, youth, and cut-and-thrust. Thank you to the marshals, the MOLs, and the fighters. It was so wonderful to have fighting back. Congratulations to Mistress Adendra on your Yellow Scarf. This honor has been long deserved.

We had the great joy of recognizing some worthy individuals at court:

Aban ibn Khalid: an Azure Cloud for his musical talent and his knowledge of historical percussion instruments.

Detlev: a Silver Cloud for his assistance at troll, breakdown, and clean-up at Warriors' Games.

Constantia Lachun: an Azure Mountain, for her contribution to the culinary arts.

We are looking forward to Our first in-person Baronial Commons in some time, on 9th of September. We hope to see many of you there.

BARONIAL EXCHEQUER

As of this date, the baronial checking account contains \$4,888.92; the WoW Wall Designated fund contains \$365.57 (included in the baronial total). \$200 has been paid to Town of Harleyville for site fee & refundable deposit for Silver Chalice and \$1,069 site rental (3-day) for RH Acres, the Fall University site, plus a \$150 refundable deposit (so far undeposited, which would bring the Account Total to \$4,730.92). \$55 was paid to Harleyville American Legion to reserve their hall for October 9, 2021 for Baronial Commons + Workshop.

The baronial trim is on hand! 335.5 yards have been sold, leaving 164.5 yards on hand. You can order some for \$2.50 per yard, checks made out to "SCA, Inc. – Barony of Hidden Mountain" and sent to me, Robert Himmelsbach, 199 Cabrill Dr., Charleston SC 29414.

The new SCA-RS credit card/PayPal reservation system is up and running for Silver Chalice. There will be a minimum user fee for each use of \$15, maximum of \$400, based on a sliding scale of 1% of total registration taken thru SCA-rs. Thus, for any event under 1,500 people reserving thru SCA-rs, there will be a \$15 user fee; PLUS 3% of each transaction. It was agreed to ask SCA-rs to change the closing date for Silver Chalice to the Thursday before the event.

Fall University in-person portion has been cancelled and University will be 2 days, all online. We received a check from Corporate for \$198.40 for fees and donations made thru SCA-rs, less \$15 and 3% fees. I have had two requests for refunds, one of which has not yet been cashed for total \$30. I have written to Corporate Office about getting the SCA Insurance refunded and was told they are no longer giving refunds for cancelled events. I have made a \$50 donation to cover the costs of the insurance. Status on the event site rental is that Lady Esme is arranging to meet the owner to get site refund money back, as well as cancelling any other arrangements relating to Fall University.

I have been in contact with the Girl Scouts regarding our rental of Camp Sandy Ridge. They and I are in agreement that obtaining a refund would be far more difficult than receiving a weekend use of the camp for what we have already paid. After further discussion, they have determined that they cannot rent us the site for the last weekend of March 2022, because the hall and kitchen will still be undergoing last stage of renovation, but they say they can accommodate us for the last full weekend of April 22–24, 2022. I said I would ask the barony for their preference and the barony has agreed. I informed the Girl Scouts on Monday 8/16/21.

As this date is OK for Baronial Birthday, I am willing to be Autocrat, and I have a budget for review at this Commons.

- Event to be spiked ASAP





At Silver Chalice on September 25th, several members of our Barony were honored and recognised with an array of Baronial awards.




