

BARONIAL EXCHEQUER

As of this date, the baronial checking account contains \$5379.16; the WoW Wall Designated fund contains \$365.57 (included in the baronial total). We have paid \$780 for one year's rental of the storage locker through December 2022. All outstanding bills have been paid, and we have one outstanding refund check for \$5 to Lord Siefrid. (HINT)

anuary is a time of fresh air and fresh starts. It's a time for embracing the new.


What's new in your life? What new projects, plans, and research have kept you warm this winter?




