

Preparations are in the works for Warriors' Games, and soon after, Silver Chalice. The drums of War are beating loudly for Pennsic and War of the Wings. Unfortunately, due to some issues with Baron Robert's work schedule, we are not able to plain on which events we can attend much in advance; this includes WOW. Due to this fact, we have decided not to pick a side for the Barony. Instead we ask everyone to support whichever side they wish.

Finally, during the last Baronial meeting, we made the formal announcement that we will not be asking for a polling of confidence. The Baronial and Kingdom Seneschals as well as the Crowns of Atlantia are aware of our decision. We have worked hard and persevered over a very difficult time. Robert and I are both very proud of everything we have done, and we are looking forward to all the excitement of the new year. If

BARONIAL EXCHEQUER

As of this date, the baronial checking account contains \$6339.58; the WoW Wall Designated Fund contains \$365.57 (included in the baronial total).

Paperwork to add the new Seneschal of the barony as an account signatory has been RE-sent to the Kingdom Exchequer and also RE-sent by her to Corporate, which has yet to respond.

The baronial trim is on hand! 392 yards have been sold, leaving 108 yards available. Buy now and avoid the rush! You can order some for \$2.50 per yard, checks made out to "SCA, Inc. – Barony of Hidden Mountain" and sent to me, Robert Himmelsbach, 199 Cabrill Dr., Charleston SC 29414.

Speaking of which: Trim sales at HMBB netted the barony \$112.50; we had a pass-through donation to the Royal Travel Fund from Baron Robert Blackhawk, and an anonymous donation to the Barony of \$72, as well as \$9 as "keep the change" at the door.

As for Baronial Birthday: We had 127 persons on site for the event. After refunds to those unable to attend who requested refunds in a timely manner, replacing the site fee of \$1,190 paid to the Girls Scouts in 2019 and rolled over since then, and reimbursing the Feast Steward for her expenses, the event netted a profit of \$820.92.

ALSO: We will need to send \$1000 to the Girl Scouts to secure the site for Fall Crown Tournament on November 4–6, 2022. This has already been sent to the Emergency Financial Committee for their review and approval, and I am now bringing it to the full Baronial Commons for a vote.

A copy of the proposed Final Crown Tournament Budget has been placed on the baronial website for review by the barony, and I am requesting a vote by the barony to approve the budget.


