

**PALIMPSEST**: (Latin, from Greek. *PAL-imp-sest*) A page or manuscript from which the text has been washed or scraped off to make room for something new; parchment was valuable enough that sometimes it was preferable to reuse it. Famous palimpsests include not only religious texts, but also ancient philosophy, science, treatises, letters, and teaching materials.

Has come to be used in other disciplines to describe an object which has been reworked for another purpose.


