



In accordance with the requirements found in the Seneschal's Handbook, those who wish to be considered as candidates must submit their Letters Of Intent (LOIs) to me (the Baronial Seneschal) at the following email address: Callintryluck@gmail.com. The LOIs must be received no later than **Saturday December 3rd 2022**. These letters should include, at a minimum, the following information for each candidate:

- Full modern and SCA names, with title
- Mailing address
- Email address
- Phone number
- Membership number and expiration date
- Statement of Intent

All letters received by the due date will be published in the Baronial newsletter, The Mountain Mayhem. The actual polling will take place January 7th through the 28th.

If you wish to have a choice in the selection, please ensure that your membership is active (and will be through the end of the year) and that your current mailing address matches the one you used when you acquired or last renewed your membership. Do not wait until the last minute to obtain or renew your membership. Also please check if you have an AEL (Atlantian Electronic Login) as the majority of the populace will want or use the electronic polling. If you wish to still use a paper ballot, please make your wishes known to me before January 3rd. Otherwise you may not receive the polling letter in January. Hidden Mount WOW Encampment 2022 Report


October 11 through 16, 2022

Hidden Mountain had thirteen actual people, and a few ghost reservations. At 250 sq ft per person, we were allocated 4,750 sq ft, but given we had more than the others, as long as we left 1200 sq ft for open camping, we split up the extra footage to allocate as illustrated.

I created a Messenger Group and included all on the Hidden Mountain paid list. I sent the illustrations on this page and the next that shows where everyone was camping in Hidden Mountain area.

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October $10^{th} - I$ arrived in the local area at my Hotel. Lord Detlev arrived for dinner and we spent the night locally so we could be on site first thing in the morning.

October 11th – Detlev and I were onsite at 8 a.m. after breakfast at the hotel. We met Darren from Steirbach who had already measured out the land so all we had to do was put out poles and gate up.

I set up my dayshade in my allocated area and helped Detlev set up his tent in his designated area.

We awaited the arrival of the rest of Hidden Mountain.

There was a food plan run by Lady Ysabeau and Lady Bjornwyn that was attended by people in Hidden Mountain, Sacred Stone and Nottinghill Coill.

Wood for the camp fire was purchased/donated by Aleyn Brus. We thank him for his generosity.

Water was supplied in the corner of our encampment (Royal Road and Ravine Road). Many others put Y connectors but we were able to attach a hose and spray handle in order to manage our water.

Port-a-jons were not far away. There was one handicap nearby. Due to a truck getting stuck in the mud, some of the port-a-Jons did not get cleaned and it was pretty bad for that day.

There were showers nearby this year. We hope they are in the same area next year.

Recommendations for Improvements in future encampments.

Request a Land Agent/Camp Coordinator at least 3 months out from the event.

- Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should hold meetings (zoom) for all who plan on attending WOW to keep everyone updated on how to register and what is needed by them before going to the event.
- Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should set up a contact with the WOW camp officials to receive and give any information needed to confirm Hidden Mountain as a camp.
- Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should coordinate with the Barony of Steirbach and the Barony of Ravens Cove for the division of the area in Purple Mountain between the Baronies.
- Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should contact all pre-registered campers and get their tent size. They should then create a camp layout of tents and set up a Messenger Group (or other similar method) to send this information to the registered campers. In this way the campers know where they will be camping before they get to the site.
- Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should be able to arrive to the WOW site early to set up the Barony camp walls/boundaries. They should stay for the entire event and if they cannot, they should arrange for someone to take down the boundaries and walls of the camp for transport back to Hidden Mountain.
- Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should stay onsite or arrange for someone to be onsite in their stead to manage any issues that arise concerning the camp logistics.

Meal Plan Coordinators should come forward the same time a Land Agent/Camp Coordinator is assigned and work with the Land Agent/Camp Coordinator for a list of people in the encampment, or other encampments, that may be interested in a meal plan.

- Meal plans are not part of an official Baronial function and is strictly volunteer. All monies are coordinated between the volunteer and recipient privately.
- The Kitchen should be in a common area where all who will be expected to clean or cook can enter without feeling they are in someone's personal area.
- When the meal plan is finalized, a schedule of meals should be posted on a white board in the encampment in plain sight so everyone who is in the meal plan knows what is on the menu and when it will be served.
- If there will be different people cooking each day, use the white board to assign by day or meal, the person who is assigned so everyone knows.
- Clean up is important so using the white board, people in the meal plan should plan on cleaning up at least one meal or day (however it is assigned depending on how many participate). Their name should be posted so they and everyone else knows who is assigned for clean-up that day.
- If clean up and trash removal are separated in tasks, again, use the white board method to assign a volunteer to the task.
- Those folks in the meal plan coming from another camp should be listed on the white board so everyone in camp knows they have a claim to be in our camp at meal times.

Fire Wood supply – We were fortunate to have Lord Aleyn who purchased all the wood for the camp. In future years that may not happen. During the Land Agent/Camp Coordinator meeting in the first 3 months prior to WOW, the group should decide how they want to acquire the wood for the camp fire and they should assign someone to bring a raised portable fire pit to burn the wood.

- \circ $\;$ Read the WOW site rules pertaining to fires and fire pits and adhere to them.
- Have a bucket of water or fire extinguisher available near the fire.
- Using the white board method, assign someone each day to the fire pit maintenance. This
 includes cleaning around the area, making sure there is kindling on hand to start a fire and that
 there is a means to start the fire. This person is tasked with starting a fire on the colder
 mornings so there is a warm fire for everyone to gather around as they get up.
- Clean up on final day If everyone enjoyed the fire during their camp time, everyone should chip in and help make sure the area is clean before everyone leaves the camp.

A smoking area should be designated with a sign so all are aware that smoking is not allowed in camp in common areas. All guests are the responsibility of their host and it is the hosts responsibility to make any smokers aware of the smoking rules. This includes electronic cigarettes and all other methods of inhaling smoke or vapor.

Guests – Guests are very welcome in our encampment. Any bad behavior by a guest should be immediately addressed by the Host or the Camp Coordinator and/or representative may ask them to leave.

Water Spiggot should be available to everyone. This year I was able to supply a hose with a handle, so maybe planning for this every year would be a good thing.

There should always be someone in camp to watch over the tents. Use the white board method to assign people. Plan ahead and coordinate efforts. It's unfortunate, but there have been reports of tent pillaging in past SCA war camps.

Showers at WOW - The Land Agent/Camp Coordinator should find out where they are and let everyone in camp know. The showers have hot water, but there were instructions for using the portable hot water heater. The Land Agent/Camp Coordinator could find out the instructions and help out the folks in camp by providing it to all.

First Aid Kit – This doesn't have to be large, but some burn cream and band aids would be nice. We have Mistress Adendra most of the time, but just in case she isn't present, we need a resource. We should have one in camp and it should be located in the common areas kitchen so everyone has access to it.

BARONIAL BIRTHDAY: Meeting in the future to discuss details.


WAR OF THE WINGS: 14 in camp, report in a file on Facebook page.

30 SECOND ART HISTORY with Bran Mydwynter


COLOPHON: (*KAHL-uh-fuhn*) In premodern manuscripts, a note at the end of a text which gives information such as the time or place it was copied, the scribe's name, the production process, and sometimes brief editorial notes.

Colophons in texts from the Islamic world became even more detailed than those in Western/Christian texts, also including additional information such as provenance and notes on the original model.

Modern colophons often begin a text instead of end it.
