

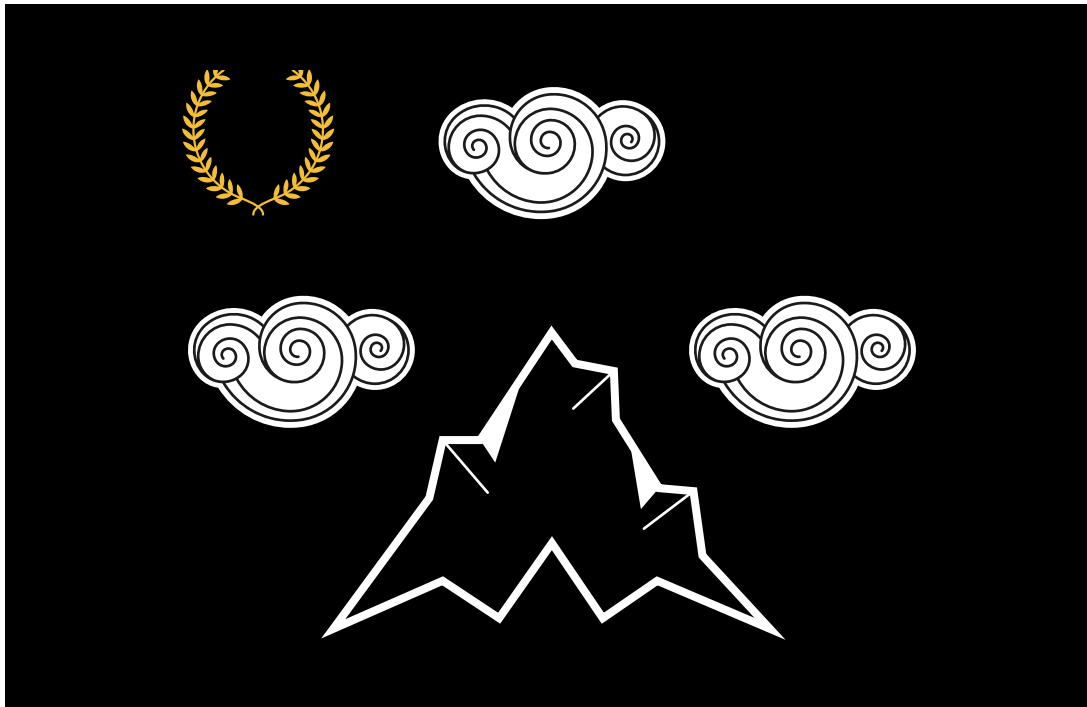

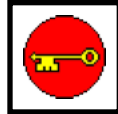

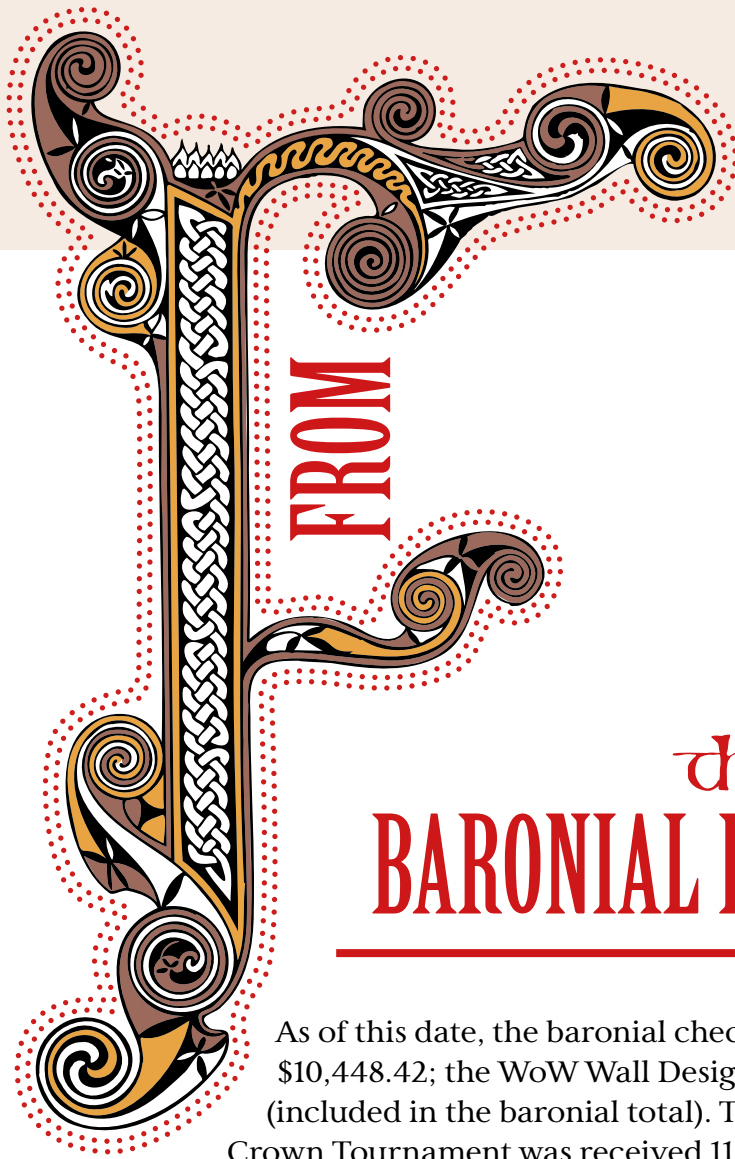

the BARONIAL EXCHEQUER

As of this date, the baronial checking account contains \$10,448.42; the WoW Wall Designated Fund contains \$365.57 (included in the baronial total). The SCA-rs check from Fall Crown Tournament was received 11/17/22 and deposited 11/18/22.

I wish to request a vote of the Barony to close the WoW Wall Designated Fund as of 12/31/22. We will no longer have a designated fund, only general funds, until such time as the barony votes otherwise.

As you may know by now, SCA-rs is ending 11/30/22; a new system for credit card registration for SCA events will be put in place sometime after that date. If you use SCA-rs to pre-reg for any event prior to 11/30/22, you will be registered, and the money you have paid will be forwarded to the group sponsoring the event. Otherwise, please use check or money order sent to the address for the registrationist in the event announcement.

My warrant as Baronial Exchequer expires March 31, 2023. I wish to retire from the position at that time, although I will see through the processing of the event report and so forth for Baronial Birthday and Investiture. We need to arrange for a replacement by that time, someone I may work with and show how we do things. Anyone who is interested in the position should contact me in writing/e-mail with their contact information, expressing their willingness to assume the position.

Event Report for Fall Crown Tournament – 11/5/2022

Fall Crown Tournament made a total event income of \$6,105.28, after requested refunds have been discounted. After all expenses have been tallied, the final event profit was \$3,919.82, which we split evenly with the Kingdom, for \$1,959.91 each.

The event report has been sent for signatures to the autocrat and thence to the Seneschal, and after it is returned to me it will be filed with all relevant paperwork.

Gentle people,

I am sorry to inform you that the current SCA-rs system for event pre-registration will end, effective Nov. 30. All events currently available on SCA-rs will be closed at midnight Eastern Wednesday, Nov. 30, 2022.

Corporate will send checks for the reservations made before that date to the event host groups in December.

Beginning Dec. 1, anyone pre-registering for an event must use cash, a check, or a money order made out to the host branch and given to the event reservationist who is identified on the event page on the Kingdom website. We are sorry for any inconvenience this causes but we ask everyone to be patient and respectful.

This decision was not made lightly but the parent company is no longer supporting the program and is taking it down at the end of the year. Corporate is working on a new, improved version of the SCA-rs system and hope to have it up very quickly, but we do not yet have a date for it. A few things to keep in mind:

An event being closed on SCA-rs does not mean that pre-registration for the event is closed! We will just need to go back to using old-fashioned, non-electronic methods to register for events, for (hopefully) a short while.

If you have already registered for an event with SCA-rs, you are registered, there is no need to register again.

I do recommend that you bring your registration confirmation email to the event to gate in, just in case there has been any confusion with the reports during this phase. A copy of the email on your phone is fine, no need to print it.

Everyone, please be patient with your event registrars and exchequers as they manage this transition.

SILVER CHALICE: Lady Caitrina will be putting in a bid.

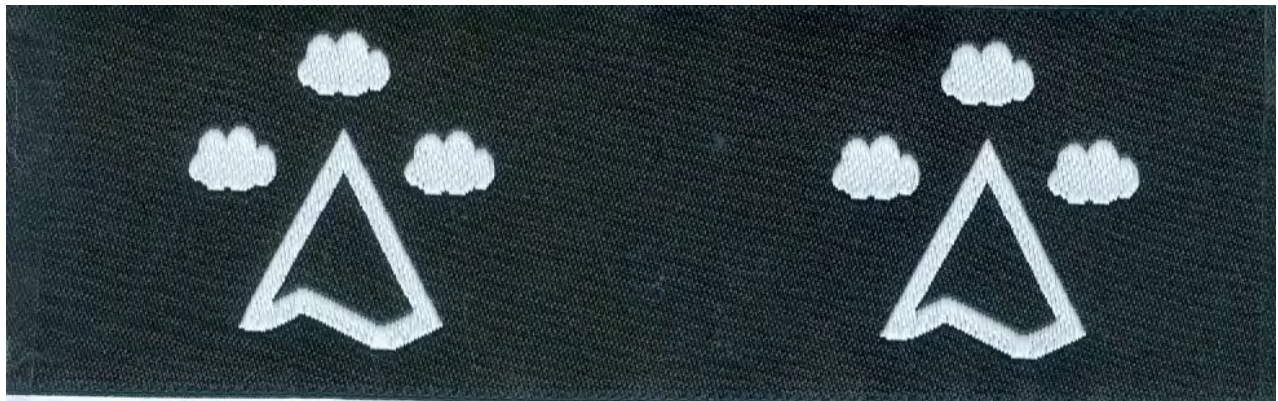
