New Business:


• War of the Wings: Jorunn cannot do onsite Land Agent this year, If you want to do this let her know, Qualan is taking over.

Dear Beda Venerabilis





From Nuremberg Chronicle, 1493

Dear Beda, Who is right? I say Halloween came from Roman traditions, but my partner says it originated in Ireland.

Samhain was considered the threshold to the season of Death. Celebrated on the last day of October by the <u>Celts</u>, who lived 2,000 years ago in the area that is now Ireland, the United Kingdom and northern France. They believed the dead returned to earth on Samhain. On that night, people gathered to light bonfires, offer sacrifices, and pay homage to the dead. It was also an agricultural festival celebrating the time of year when "the summer goes to rest". It was a period of "supernatural intensity" where the force of darkness and decay were said to be abroad, emerging from ancient barrows. Revelers often disguised themselves in animal skins to deceive these spirits.

Samhain was a *liminal*, festival, a separation between "summer and winter, lightness and darkness" when the normal order of

the universe is suspended and ritual transition and altered states were expected.

Celebrants joined Druid priests to light a community fire using a wheel that would cause friction and spark flames. Participants took a flame from the bonfire back to their home to relight the hearth, which was believed to provide protection for the home. To honor the departed, appease hungry spirits and protect the living, food was left out on doorsteps and forest edges. In later centuries, people began dressing as ghosts, demons, and other malevolent creatures during Samhain, performing antics in exchange for food and drink. This custom, known as mumming, dates to the Middle Ages and is thought to be an antecedent of trick-or-treating. **Continued on next page**



Dear Beda Venerabilis—cont.

In 1000 A.D. the church designated November 1 as All Souls' Day, a time for honoring the dead. Their celebrations resembled Celtic rituals, including bonfires and masquerades. Poor people would visit the houses of wealthier families and receive pastries called soul cakes in exchange for a promise to pray for the souls of the homeowners' dead relatives. Known as "souling," the practice was later taken up by children, who would go from door to door asking for gifts such as food, money, and ale. Young people took part in a tradition called guising, dressing up in costume and accepting offerings from various households. Rather than pledging to pray for the dead, they would sing a song, recite a poem, tell a joke or perform another sort of "trick" before collecting their treat, which typically consisted of fruit, nuts or coins.

Over time, as Celtic communities were conquered by Christianity many meanings behind the original Samhain changed, what the pagans called magic, the Catholics called miraculous. The night that preceded All Saints Day became known as All Hallows Eve, later Hallow Evening, and eventually, Halloween.


To answer your question, Halloween seems to have come from the Irish, Celtic Samhain celebration observed on October 31st. But it was also greatly influenced by the Catholic Church. In my opinion, you are both correct.

Now, stop arguing about it, and have fun celebrating Halloween, and remember, there will be Trick or Treating at War of the Wings!




