Book Review-Ivanhoe

Walter Scott was born in 1771 in Edinburgh, Scotland. His 1819's novel, Ivanhoe, was set in England at the end of the twelfth century. It tells the story of Ivanhoe, a knight who was involved with King Richard I, "Richard the Lion-Hearted" as he return to England from the crusades. The two main characters are Norman King Richard and Saxon Wilfred of Ivanhoe, a young knight who served King Richard on Crusade.

The back story: While King Richard was absent, England fell into a dismal state at the hands of his brother, Prince John -- the greedy ruler featured in Robin Hood stories. During this time the Saxons, who ruled England until the Battle of Hastings in 1066, and the Normans, who conquered the Saxons, were in constant conflict as the Norman nobles gobbled up Saxon lands. During this time King Richard made enemies of both Austria and Germany when he did not acknowledge Henry VI, Emperor of Germany, as the ruler of Sicily when he signed the Treaty of Messina.

As Richard was returning to England from his crusade, in 1192, he was captured in Vienna by Leopold V, the Duke of Austria and sold to Germany. The Germans demanded a large ransom for the king, however corrupt John was not inclined to pay. It took two years for Richard's allies in England to raise the money for his in release. Richard returned to England in secret, hiding his identity as he waited for his allies to raise a force to protect him from Prince John and his allies. Ivanhoe takes place just after Richard's landing in England.

Ivanhoe joined the crusade after he had been disinherited by his father, Cedric, an old-blood Saxon nobleman who despises the Normans. Cedric has a beautiful ward, the Lady Rowena, who is descended from King Harold. He plans to wed her to his friend Athelstane, a descent of a past Saxon King, and

found a new dynasty to throw off the Norman oppressors. Ivanhoe and Rowena, however, are in love. Cedric disinherits Ivanhoe for hindering his plans for Rowena and for following King Richard, a Norman, into battle.

The story portrays the many social conflicts of the time. Norman vs Saxon, slaves vs church- (which is often portrayed as evil). Christians vs jews. Father vs son. Ivanhoe experienced great internal struggles as well. He came to believe that simply being loyal to your principals isn't necessarily a good thing. If you follow a moral code that is unjust, you become unjust, no matter how unwavering your principles are.

The most important aspect of the novel is, in my opinion, that it is a rip roaring, well told story that is as engaging today as it was when first written in 1819. Even Robin Hood and Friar make an appearance. The adventures pile one on top of another. It's great fun, especially with the witticisms of Cedric's jester.




8 members attended
