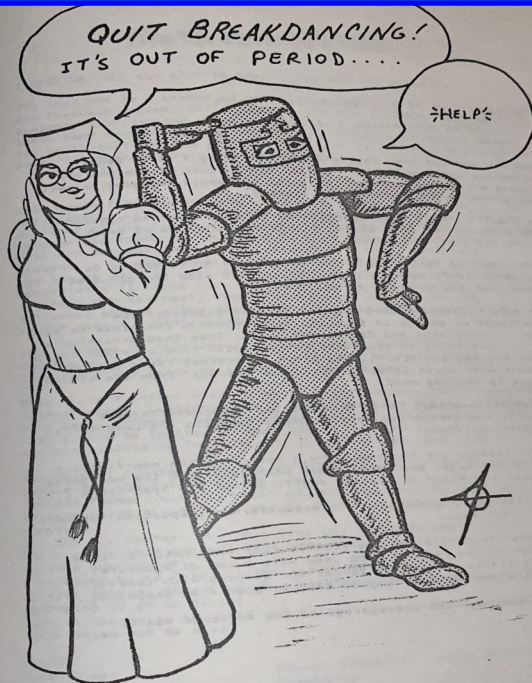



This month in Hidden Mountain History:

April Edition of Mountain Volume II No. 8 an excerpt from the greetings page.

“Congratulations to Syr Eldon Ungol, Baron of Hidden Mountain. That’s right, our Baron has become the youngest knight in Atlantia. The ceremony took place at The Feast of Thirty. It was truly one of the most moving and eloquent knighting ever seen. The Honorable Lord Eldon Ungol was removed from the field of battle, cleansed with cold water and sent to his vigil in the woods. During the day, the Peers of the Realm gave advice to the Knight-to-be. During Court that evening, Lord Eldon was elevated to Knighthood by King Olaf. Duke Sir Girth and Duke Sir Richard placed the spurs upon his feet, Lady Fiona Lachtne girded him in his white belt, and Syr Richard de Montbrai buffeted the newest Knight of Atlantia. Great rejoicing followed.”—April A.S. XX, Vol II Issue No. 8, Mountain Mayhem (OP Date for knighting 3/29/1986)

2/6/1982—Award of Arms, Given at Manannan Mac Lir III

1/14/1984—Companion of the Queen’s Order of Courtesy, Given at Kingdom Twelfth Night

3/25/1984—Grant of Arms, Given at Hidden Mountain Investiture, which thus he became the Territorial Baron of Hidden Mountain and founded our beloved Barony.

9/8/1984—Companion of the Golden Dolphin & Companion of the Sea Stag, Given at Two Harolds Bridge Battle

3/29/1986—Knighted at the Feast of Thirty

Hidden Mountain Baronial Meeting

Officer Report by: Lord Seifrid Wolfhart

Seneschal: - Quarterly Report, Deputy Seneschal Warrant. He did send out messages to all baronial officers to ensure that emails were active and to ensure that they were still in office. He will be getting with Ingvar to get the Deputy Seneschal Warrant set up.

Baronage: Their excellencies do not have a whole lot to report right now. They are getting ready for Crown Tournament. If you need anything from Baronial Storage unit, deadline is TUESDAY NIGHT the last day in April to get your request in. Bish did request to see if they had possession of Baronial Feast Gear, it will be requested before they are on-site.

Exchequer: As of this date, the checking account holds \$8,481.43. We have one outstanding refund check from HMBB for \$34 yet to be cashed. As of this date we still have not received the SCORES check from Corporate for an additional \$1224. I have written to the Kingdom Exchequer and to the Deputy for SCORES requesting follow-up on this issue. We currently have reserved Camp Sandy Ridge for the 1st weekend in May for Spring Crown Tourney. I will be sending a check for \$400 for cash box cash to Lady Charlotte (Hannah Mae Jackson) who will be one of the co-trolls for the event. Please cash it and bring the \$100 in tens; \$200 in fives; and \$100 in ones to the event. We have the Harleyville site reserved for 9/28/2024 for the Silver Chalice Tournament and have received confirmation of the new date. This will also be the culminating Titans Tournament.

Minister of the Lists: Qulan reports that the warrant site is still working on checking all warrants are active and valid. Please check the website and ensure that it is up to date because links do not sync properly sometimes.

Knight's Marshal: Nothing new to Report.

Misty Marsh by the Sea: Did not attend.

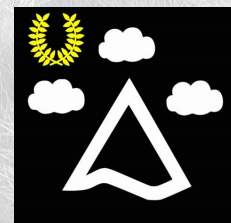

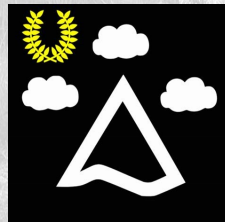
Officer Report Continued

Meeting Changes: Discuss the changes to Saturday at 1 or 2pm and the introduction of in person meetings rotated through the cantons.



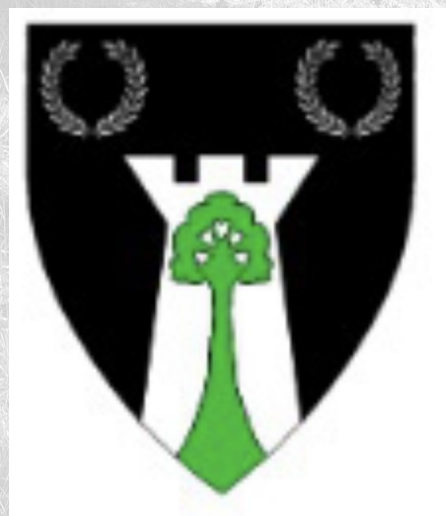
Canton of Moorhaven



