

Hidden Mountain Baronial Meeting

Officer Report by: Lord Seifrid Wolfhart

Seneschal: Nothing new that is major to report. He's sure that everyone knows that we have new Heirs.

Baronage: From their perspective, crown was wonderful, well attended. Everyone seemed to be having a great time, everything looked amazing and there was a great timing to everything. We had 243 people in attendance at crown. Despite the weather, it was a great success. The baron has been working on building new poles for the Erick (field gear) and he will be turning in some receipts for reimbursement. Some are damaged, especially since they are wooden, he is looking for metal caps to help preserve the wood instead of breaking the new pieces.

Exchequer: As of this date, the checking account holds \$12,707.15 As of this date we still have not received the SCORES check from Corporate for an additional \$2,991.80. At this time, I am requesting Baroni-al approval for a series of re-imbursements: \$400 to myself for the cash for the cashbox, which had to come out of my own account. \$229.62 to myself for supplies acquired for cleaning (since I have a Costco card) on behalf of the event. These were passed for reimbursement by the group. \$1,083.47 for Norman Smith for food costs and supplies for feast. This was passed for reimbursement by the group. \$63.37 for E.L. Wimett for paper supplies for printing procession and list cards & program. This was passed for reimbursement by the group. \$323.69 for Candace Smith for breakfast & luncheon foods & fixings. This was passed for reimbursement. \$63.94 for Brenda Butler for paper goods & supplies. This was passed for reimbursement. \$30 Refund to Wendi Day for Pr & Prs Comp'd attendance. This was passed for reimbursement. \$39 Refund to Mary T. Kearney (Mor the Merry) who could not attend and requested a refund before the event. This was passed for reimbursement. Crown tournament, after all expenses are paid, will yield a profit of \$2,296.75 to be split 50/50 with the Kingdom or \$1,148.38 for the Barony. \$150 for 15 NMR fees has already been sent to the Kingdom Exchequer. We have the Harleyville site reserved for 9/28/2024 for the Silver Chalice Tournament and have received confirmation of the new date. This will also be the culminating Titans Tournament.

Minister of the Lists: Did not attend.

Knight's Marshal: Nothing new to Report.

Chronicler: Charlotte reports that all media/photos/missives and anything that is requested to be in the newsletter be emailed with releases emailed to the Chronicler by May 25th. She also is wanting to get with Jorunn about either digitizing or using some of the previous issues for this month in History for previous issues and to encourage some of our legacy.

Chatelaine: Ysabeau reports that we had a great turnout for the sew-a-thon, Charlotte and herself are looking forward to bringing it down Tear-Sea's Shore to work through another event to get more garb together. Baroness & Chatelaine were working together on maybe creating an event or picnic to bring more attention to what exactly this barony is about. She is still trying to nail down a date and do the hospitality hall to where we can consistently do the event

Canton Reports:

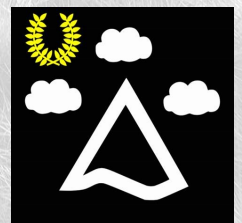
Misty Marsh by the Sea: Did not attend.

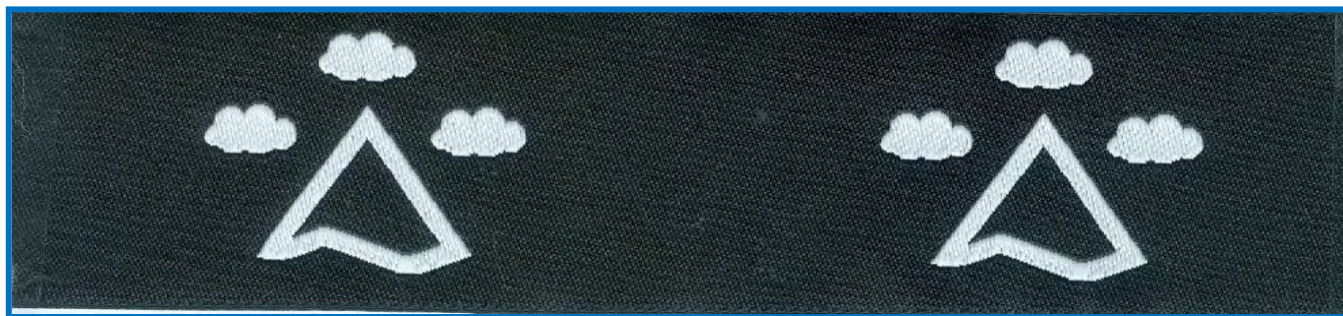



