Hidden Mountain Baronial Meeting

Officer Report by: Lord Seiffred Wolfhart

Meeting called to order: 02:11pm

Officer Reports:

Seneschal: Seneschal reports that there is nothing new to be sharing. He is updating us about the abeyance during this meeting.

Baronage: Their excellencies reports that we have silver chalice and university coming up. If you are needing anything special from the baronial storage unit, with enough time to get what you need, at minimum 72 hours. Anyone that wants to nominate for award recommendations so we can recognize those that deserve it.

Exchequer: Bish reports the checking account holds \$12,113.59; SCORES for Silver Chalice has been set up and is now available. Registration for WoW is now available. We have the Harleyville site reserved for 9/28/2024 for the Silver Chalice Tournament and have received confirmation of the date. This will also be the culminating Titans Tournament. Baronial Trim is still available for sale; \$2.50/yd, contact the Exchequer and I will have at Warrior's Games and Silver Chalice. The Baronial wall fund is still in effect; if you have any expenses related to The Wall, please get your receipts to him. We need an approved budget for Baronial Birthday submitted and a vote on spending the presumed \$1,000.00 for the site rental for next year.

Minister of the Lists: Did not attend meeting. The message from our MoL was passed to the Seneschal through zoom, but there was nothing new to report except for praise for Bish and his dedication to the MoL's.

Knight's Marshal: Baron Hrothgar reports that there is nothing new. He is interested in arranging a Baronial Practice, possibly in the Georgetown area due to the fact that it would be the middle ground between Tear-Sea's & Moorhaven. Qulan informed his excellency about a park with parking, boardwalk space and possible restrooms but was not fully sure, did offer to look into it for their excellency.

Chronicler: Charlotte reports that all media/photos/missives and anything that is requested to be in the newsletter be emailed with releases emailed to the Chronicler by July 25th. As long as the items are turned in before the 5th of the following month she will do her best to get it inputted into the next issue of Mountain of Mayhem.

Canton Reports:

Misty Marsh by the Sea: Currently in Abeyance. Seneschal asked kingdom on behalf of barony, if we needed to take on the funds and place them in a special reserve. Kingdom will be maintaining that part and that we do not have to do anything on our end. Once Misty Marsh is ready to go active, they have 2 years to do so. They will start back up as if nothing happened. Everything will be held by the kingdom. If anyone would be wanting to do an event to bring alive the area, to be able to re-establish, Seneschal believes that he can make someone an autocrat (That is a member) to do the event on behalf of Barony Seneschal.

Tear Sea's Shore: They meet every 3rd Sunday of every month. They are currently working towards Fall University 2024 on 9/21. They have a full contact social starting @ 2pm with a small fighter practice there as well. Their next canton meeting is 8/18 @ 6pm.

Moorhaven: They are meeting the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month, at Panera in Carolina Forest. They are currently doing AnS at their Katherine of the Doves. They have money and that is about all they have to report at this time.

Old Business:

Silver Chalice: Ysabeau was not present for the meeting and has been working on Silver Chalice. Due to her Facebook being hacked has been struggling to get things updated. 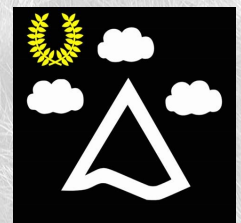

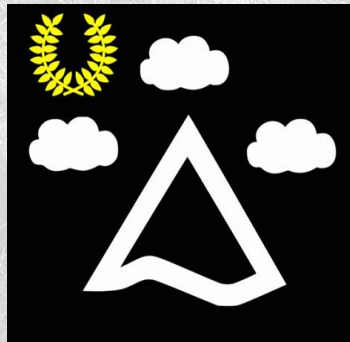
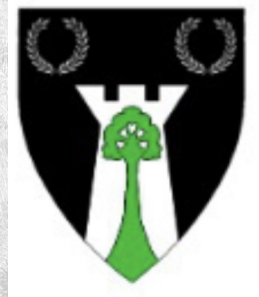
Officer Report Continued



