We are looking forward to seeing everyone there. We are all desperately in need of a good distraction.


We hope this missive finds you well, and if you need to speak with us for whatever reason, please feel free to reach out. We are available by phone, text or email.

Total Attendees: 20 Meeting called to order: 03:00pm

Officer Reports:

Seneschal: Seneschal reports nothing new to report that is pressing. He does know of stuff that will be brought forward next month but we are waiting for a bigger meeting to discuss it more thoroughly with kingdom.

Baronage: Their excellencies report that if you anything special that is needed for university. They are bringing the large pavilion. They will be bringing an extra throne for Silver Chalice.

Exchequer: Bish reports the checking account holds \$12,113.59; SCORES for Silver Chalice has been set up and is now available. Registration for WoW is now available. All persons who are supposed to be signatories on the Baronial Account are now registered as such with First Citizens, as confirmed with the SCA's banker. We have the Harleyville site reserved for 9/28/24 for the Silver Chalice Tournament and have received confirmation of the date. This will also be the culminating of Titans Tournament. Baronial Trim is available for sale; \$2.50/yd, contact the Exchequer and I will have at Silver Chalice. The Baronial wall fund is still in effect; if you have any expenses related to the wall, please get your receipts to me. We need an approved budget for Baronial Birthday submitted and a vote on spending the presumed \$1,000.00 for the site rental for next year.

Minister of the Lists: Did not attend meeting. The message from our MoL was passed to the Seneschal through zoom, but there was nothing new to report except for praise for Bish and his dedication to the MoL's.

Knight's Marshal: Baron Hrothgar reports that there is nothing new.

Chronicler: Charlotte reports that all media/photos/missives and anything that is requested to be in the newsletter be emailed with releases emailed to the Chronicler by July 25th. As long as the items are turned in before the 5th of the following month she will do her best to get it inputted into the next issue of Mountain of Mayhem.

Chatelaine: Ysabeau reports that she is still wanting to set up a Hospitality Hall, via zoom for a little while to see if there is any interest in them. She is very much interested in getting a Baronial Picnic in the works. Charlotte did speak up and mention that since the Baron was wanting to get a fighter practice in that maybe we could do both at the same time and have the picnic and the practice. Closest Date that was previously proposed was 8/17/2024. No vote was taken at this time, so there is currently no date set for any such picnic.

Tear Sea's Shore: They meet every 3rd Sunday of every month. They are currently working towards Fall University 2024 on 9/21, starts @ 7am for set up only. The site officially opens at 9am. They have spiked Manannan for 18th of January. They are going to be accepting a bid from Yrsa for Warrior's games 2025.

Moorhaven: They are meeting the 2nd and 4th Tuesday of the month, at Panera in Carolina Forest. They are currently working on baskets for the Silent Auction for Silver Chalice.

Old Business:

Silver Chalice: Ysabeau was not present for the meeting and has been working on Silver Chalice. We are working on contacting the American legion to see about renting the two bathrooms that are available there, they are \$75 to rent the space. Seneschal is working on getting in contact, so is Ysabeau. They both have asked Adendra to reach out to the rental agent that she talks to about Harleyville to see about contact information. Backup plan is about \$300 for rental of port-o-potty's. It was proposed to the group to approve the \$300 in case American Legion is unavailable. It was seconded and unanimously voted upon for approval. Once we hear about the Legion's availability there will be a meeting of heads for possible approval of those funds.

New Business:

Baronial Birthday 41: We now have an official budget submitted by Lady Arabella. Budget proposed food cost, 880, general 150, site charge 1000, 50 insurance add on, total 2,080 for the entire event. We will make adjustments at a later date if needed with the Autocrat.

Announcements:

Bish is the land agent this year for the Barony of Hidden Mountain for War of the Wings. As such, I need to know how many people / tents are going to camp with us this year. Including tent size and when to expect arrival and departure. As of this date, the only person who has space reserved in our encampment is Me, and my two ghosts, myself and I. I will not organize or coordinate meals. I will be away from the campsite frequently MoL-ing. If you have or will be registering for WoW via SCORES, please also indicate if you are staying with the mountain on the spreadsheet. Assume whatever your tent size is and 2' in each measurement to account for ropes and stakes. Mine is 13' by 13', but I will enter 15' x 15'. Plus, two ghosts I paid for.


