

Baronial Polling Information

Letter from the Regional Deputy Seneschal of Atlantia

Unto the populace of the Barony of Hidden Mountain come Greetings!

Their Excellencies Hrothgar and Isabella intend to step down as Baronage at the end of Their current term, on March 28, 2026. Thus it is time to begin the process of selecting Their successors.

In accordance with the requirements found in the Atlantian Great Book of Law, those who wish to be considered as candidates must submit their Letters of Intent (LOIs) to me (Dame Morwenna Trevethan) at the following email address: depsenscga@atlantia.sca.org.

The LOIs must be received no later than Saturday December 6, 2025. These letters must include, at a minimum, the following information for each candidate:

- -- Full legal name
- -- SCA name and title
- -- Email address
- -- Membership number and expiration date
- -- Statement of Intent

All letters received by the due date, and subsequently approved by the Kingdom Seneschal and Their Majesties, will be published in The Mountain Mayhem. The actual polling will take place between January 10th through January 31st, 2026.

If you wish to have a choice in the selection of Hidden Mountain's next baronage, please ensure that your membership is active (and will be through February 14) and that your current postal mailing address and email address match the ones you used when you acquired or last renewed your membership. Do not wait until the last minute to obtain or renew your membership. Also, make sure that you have an AEL (Atlantian Enterprise Login) and an ESP (Electronic System for Pollings) login, in order to use the electronic polling. If you have difficulties getting these two logins, contact your baronial or canton seneschal for assistance. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact me.

Thanks also are due to Lord Seiffrid Wolfhart, baronial seneschal, for his help getting this information published.

AEL Sign on and Polling Set Up

Helpful Info on AEL and Polling

Here are some instructions to help ensure that you CAN participate in Hidden Mountain's Baronial Polling next year.

- 1. Confirm that your (the member's) SCA membership is active, via the SCA.org page.
- -- Ensure that your membership is paid at least through the end of the Polling. (i.e. at least through the middle of February: 2/14/26) You will not have a voice / a vote in this process if you are not a current SCA member.
- -- Verify that your mailing and email addresses are current. Go to the SCA.org Membership page and check the contact information listed there. Correct it, if needed.
- 2. Confirm or get an AEL.
 - -- If in the past 5 years, you have:
 - -- logged into the University of Atlantia
 - -- nominated someone for an award using the on-line Award Recommendation System
- -- been a fighter who retrieved a copy of your authorization card from the Authorization Card Database, OR
- -- been a member of a polling order (Pelican, Pearl, Kraken, etc.) and have responded to an electronic polling for that order

then you already have an Atlantian Enterprise Login and can skip this section and proceed to section

- -- However, if none of the above items are true, then do the following.
- -- Go to https://www.login.atlantia.sca.org/request.php and complete the top and bottom portions (user information and password)
 - -- Click on 'Register Account'
- 3. Have your Atlantian Enterprise Login (AEL) connected to the Electronic System for Polling Orders (ESP).
- -- Go to the Electronic System for Polling Orders (ESP) website: https://polling.atlantia.sca.org/account-register.php
 - -- Login using the information you entered for your AEL, and also enter your membership number
 - -- Click on 'I'm not a Robot', then click on 'Register Account'

Completing these steps will ensure that you can participate in the polling.

NOTE: Only people who reside in the zip-code-defined lands of Hidden Mountain are eligible to participate in this polling. Our recent former monarchs Abran and Anya instituted a change to Atlantian Law that will permit a non-resident to participate electronically by noting that he/she/they wish to claim Hidden Mountain as their home for purposes of the polling. However, I don't know if this change has occurred yet and where / how it should be noted. If a non-resident wishes to provide counsel to Their Majesties regarding any of the candidates, such a person always has the option of sending an email to Their Majesties with their words.

Award Submission How-To-Guide

Award Submission Guide

The best time to submit an award recommendation is now! Your friends, family, and even distant acquaintances have likely done some work that is should be recognized by all. This small guide will help streamline the process and take out any guess work and help get people recognition that they have earned!

This guide is to help everyone, new and old alike, navigate the <u>Award Recommendation System</u> (ARS) and get those awards submitted for your Baronage and Their Royal Majesties to see.

Step 1: Log in

In order to access the ARS, you must have a log in. ARS uses Atlantian Enterprise Login (AEL) so if you've ever signed in for the University of Atlantia, Orders of the Laurel, Pelican, Pearl, or Golden Dolphin – you're ready to go! There is a chance you'll still need to connect your account with your SCA membership but that's super easy, you just type in your account number. For this process, I have logged in as myself. Here is what your screen should look like:



Step 2: Enter their name

This is to help find their entry in th Order of Precedence (OP). Why is this important? Some people have very similar names, some may have changed their name. All in all, it's to help make sure you are selecting the right person to get the right award. That could be awkward.

All Submissions are Due by the 25th of every month.

If you wish to submit models, art, poetry, or want to submit photos please complete and email the signed release forms to the Chronicler Email.

- These forms MUST be signed, an electronic signature is OK.
- The Grant of Use Form is used by an author or artist for articles, poems, stories, songs, etc. or for original artwork (not clip art). Note that no form is needed for correspondence from officers or autocrats, for event notices, or for captions: https://chronicler.atlantia.sca.org/
