

## Letter from the Regional Deputy Seneschal

Unto the populace of Hidden Mountain come Greetings!

With the concurrence of Their Majesties Athos and Alianora, I present three Letters of Intent (LOIs) from gentles wishing to become the next Baron and/or Baroness of Hidden Mountain.

These LOIs are for you to consider until Saturday January 10, 2026. On that date the official polling will begin. The polling window will be open from Saturday January 10, 2026 through Saturday January 31, 2026.

In order to participate in the polling, you must: -- be an SCA member at least through the end of the polling;

-- live within the zip-code-defined boundaries of the barony.

To submit your polling ballot, please do the following:

- Go to <https://polling.atlantia.sca.org/>
- Click on Account, Log in, using the AEL (Atlantian Enterprise Login) that you already should have connected to the ESP (Electronic System for Pollings)
- Click on "If you are looking for the Pollings for the Baronies, please Switch to Baronial Pollings."
- Read the polling form in its entirety
- Select the candidate or candidate team you most prefer, by marking it as #1
- Mark the remaining candidates or candidate teams as #2, or #3. NOTE: all candidate teams must be ranked for your response to be considered
- After each candidate's or candidate team's LOI (Letter of Intent), type in any comments you may have about that person or team
- Review what you've typed (your candidate ranking and comments) to ensure it's accurate. Once you have submitted your response, you can not change it!
- If you wish to have a copy of your response sent to you, click on "Email this Response"
- Click on Submit Response
- Log off

## Letter of Intent: Master Geoffrey d'Ayr of Montalban

I have been twice married, divorced from my late wife for some 50 years and widowed from my late husband for 10. I am a non-practicing Quaker (Society of Friends) and a Democratic Socialist.

In the SCA, I have fought in armored combat, albeit in Pennsic 2 and 3, and never since. I received my OM and OL for period cooking, recipe redaction and feast preparation, my OSC and Pelican for my service in Bhakail and as Brigantia Principal Herald of the East. I was the first member of the BoD from East of the Rockies, and while it has mostly been changed and revised, there are still a few small bits of "Corpora" I can identify as "I wrote that". I took an approximate 13-year hiatus from the SCA before my retirement, as my career had taken over most of my available time and travel budget, returning after retirement and relocation to Charleston SC 11 years ago. (It is all different now!)

I permanently reside in Charleston and have often hosted local (Tear-Sea's Shore) and Baronial meetings and classes. Between pension and Social Security, I can safely claim to be comfortably well-off, and able to afford the additional expenses of travel, transport, and other costs of the office. I do NOT however, drive a vehicle (Philadelphia has an excellent public transit system when it works; Charleston does not) but I rely on the kindness of friends and my housemate to get to places.

I am currently engaged in collecting period cookbooks and period counted-thread embroidery patterns and produce a fair quantity of cross-stitch and blackwork embroideries, many of which I give away in my determined effort to drag the Kingdom of Atlantia into the Renaissance! I make Late Medieval and Italian Renaissance garb and keep trying to get 16th C garb right, with awkward results.

I should note for the benefit of the Monarchs that I do not, and never have, swear/sworn fealty to any Crown or Kingdom. As a Quaker, we do not swear oaths and as a Bishop (I have permission from Laurel to use as an alternative title to "Master") the Council of Clermont of 1095 forbade higher clergy to swear fealty to any Monarch. However, as do most modern Quakers when on jury duty and the like, I will affirm or make an affirmation to the effect of upholding the rules and regulations of the Society, if that is acceptable to Their Majesties. If this is NOT an acceptable variant to their Majesties, I respect your decision to reject my candidacy.
